

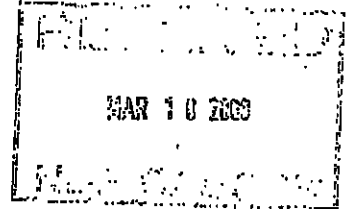

TO THE HONOURABLE

THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

The undersigned has the honour to report that:



1. Section 4 of *The Trade Union Act* provides, in part, as follows:

"4(1) There shall continue to be a board known as the Labour Relations Board composed of members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council at such salaries or remuneration as he deems fit; the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall name a chairperson and two vice-chairpersons of the board; the members of the board shall be selected so that employers and organized employees are equally represented.

(1.1) The members of the board:

(a) shall be appointed to hold office for terms not exceeding:

(i) five years in the case of the chairperson and vice-chairpersons; and

(ii) three years in the case of other members; and

(b) may be reappointed for additional terms.

(11) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint an executive officer who shall be an agent of the board and shall perform such duties as the board may from time to time direct."

2. Section 20 of *The Interpretation Act, 1995* provides as follows:

"20(1) Subject to subsection (2), notwithstanding any other enactment or any agreement, if a person is a member of a board, commission or other appointed body of the Government of Saskatchewan or any of its agencies or Crown corporations on the day on which the Executive Council is first installed following a general election as defined in *The Election Act*, the term of office for which that person was appointed is deemed to end on the earlier of:

(a) the last day of the term for which the person was appointed; or

(b) a day designated by the Lieutenant Governor in Council or the person who made the appointment.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a person whose appointment is expressly stated in an Act to be subject to termination by the Legislative Assembly."

3. By Your Honour's Order 640/2007, dated August 14, 2007, the following persons were

4. It is desirable and in the public interest to designate a date on which the terms of office of the Chairperson and Vice-chairpersons of the Labour Relations Board are deemed to end, to revise the membership and remuneration of the Labour Relations Board and to appoint an executive officer of the Labour Relations Board.

The undersigned has the honour, therefore, to recommend that Your Honour's Order do issue pursuant to section 4 of *The Trade Union Act* and section 20 of *The Interpretation Act, 1995*:

(a) designating March 6, 2008 as the day on which the term of office of James E. Seibel as member and Chairperson of the Labour Relations Board is deemed to end and cancelling his appointment to that office;

(b) designating March 6, 2008 as the day on which the terms of office of Angela Zborosky and Catherine Zuck, Q.C. as members and Vice-Chairpersons of the Labour

Relations Board are deemed to end and cancelling their appointments to those offices;

(c) appointing Ken Love, Regina, as a member of the Labour Relations Board to serve at pleasure for a term not exceeding five years from the date of this Order;


(d) naming Ken Love as Chairperson of the Labour Relations Board;

(e) appointing Ken Love as executive officer of the Labour Relations Board; and

(f) establishing the rate of remuneration of Ken Love as member, Chairperson and executive officer of the Labour Relations Board at \$180,000 per annum.


