Dear Sisters and Brothers:

**RE: Prairie School for Union Women
June 13-17, 2010**

There are 3 things that I want to draw your attention to:

1. We are **considering chartering a bus from Saskatoon to Waskesiu**. In the past we have provided transportation to only the women flying in from other provinces. This year we will be charging \$75 (includes return trip and park entrance fee). If we can get a big enough commitment from Saskatoon and area women we will go ahead and provide the charter bus. If not – those flying into Saskatoon will still be provided a ride at the cost of \$75. This is a trial for 2010 and if successful we may look at offering a bus from Regina. **Please check the appropriate box on the registration form**. Further information will be provided as soon as we have enough commitment. This is not only good for the environment but a great way to start making connections with others!
2. The **early bird deadline for registration** has been set back 2 weeks from prior years. Please get your paid registrations in early – we anticipate a full house this year!
3. The course *Young Workers in Action* is intended for young women 29 and under. One of the goals of the PSUW is to enable young workers to become active in their unions and communities through education and support. Please encourage young women in your union to sign up for this very interesting course.
